Jeff Grunow has been employed for 10 years at Weber State University as an associate professor. He serves both as faculty and Chair for the Emergency Care & Rescue Department. His principle teaching role includes educating Emergency Medical Technicians and Paramedics. He has been a Nationally Registered paramedic and masters prepared registered nurse for almost 30 years. While his area of expertise is emergency medical service (EMS), he has over 15 years of experience as a volunteer fire fighter. As part of his university responsibilities he actively collaborates with the Ogden and Roy fire/paramedic units.
