Coaches and parents, please remember that this is designed for the boys to have **FUN** while learning the fundamentals of basketball. *Please remember that this is a learning league and that the officials will teach the kids as they make their calls. **As the season progresses, more things will be called!** You can't learn if you are not taught how to do it right. The goal is to get all of the kids to learn the game, have fun and learn good sportsmanship. We ask that you encourage your parents and yourselves not to question the calls of the officials.*

Spectators and Players: We encourage all spectators and participants not to question decisions of the officials. Please remember that we are using facilities owned by Weber County Schools and we must abide by the rules that they have set forth. **All players and spectators must obey the verbal instructions of the supervisors and/or the building custodians.** Use of profane or abusive language will result in removal from the game. A second offense will result in the offending party being dropped from the program for the year. Intentional roughness, fighting (on or off court) or rowdy conduct will be cause for removal. The conduct of players, spectators, and parents must be in good taste and consistent with North League Parks & Recreation, Weber County School District and Weber County Recreation policies. Any player, spectator or parent who does not adhere to these policies will be asked to leave the building and in the case of a parent, will result in their child being removed from the game. If circumstances are of a serious nature (profanity, abusive language, threatening of an official, etc.) a forfeit can be called on the violating team.

Special rules may be put into place per the Health Department/Weber School District due to Covid 19. All participants and spectators will abide by said rules or they will not be allowed to participate or attend games.
