

# Washington Boulevard

400 North to 2600 North

To preserve and extend the life of the pavement, the Utah Department of Transportation (UDOT) will begin a project to resurface SR-235 (Washington Boulevard) in North Ogden between 400 North (North Street) and 2600 North. Our crews will start by replacing sidewalk pedestrian ramps along the corridor during daytime work hours on Monday, May 1.

This project also includes upgrades to road signs and the installation of a new concrete platform at the UTA bus stop located near the southwest corner of Washington Boulevard and 2550 North.

Road resurfacing will start as soon as nighttime temperatures increase and will take place **nightly through late-June, Sunday through Thursday, between the hours of 7 p.m. and 5 a.m.** On-street parking will be prohibited once resurfacing activities begin.

During work hours you can anticipate:

-  Lane closures and reduced speeds
-  Moderate travel delays
-  Temporary access restrictions during resurfacing
-  Increased noise and vibrations at night

For your safety, and the safety of our crews working on the road, please use extra caution and stay alert when driving near the work zone. *Construction schedules are subject to change due to weather conditions or material availability.*
