STORM WATER UPDATE

The Utah Department of Environmental Quality is requiring all cities and counties on the Wasatch Front to adopt additional storm water regulations as part of Phase II of the Clean Water Act. These regulations require the implementation of "Low Impact Development Standards" for all new development. Harrisville City has adopted the new regulations and updated the current storm water ordinances to conform to the state requirements. Residents and businesses will notice cities placing additional emphasis on storm water containment and oversight. With this unfunded state mandate comes an increased cost for the storm water management program. Therefore, Harrisville City raised the monthly residential Storm Water Utility Fee from \$3.00 to \$4.25. Thanks you for your doing your part to help keep our water clean and free of pollution. Our community is working hard to make life better.

Public Hearing

In accordance with Utah Code Section 10-9a-205, notice is hereby provided that the Harrisville Planning Commission will hold a public hearing on March 11, 2020 at 7:00 p.m., in the Harrisville City Legislative Chambers located at 363 West Independence Blvd., Harrisville, Utah, to take public comment for and against the proposed Harrisville Ordinance 508; Large Project Master Planned Communities/Mixed Use/In-Fill and General Plan Amendments. Individuals requiring special accommodation (including auxiliary communicative aids and services) should notify the City Recorder at 801-782-4100 at least three (3) days prior to the hearing.

Notice to Fill Midterm Vacancy in Municipal Office

In accordance with Utah Code 20A-1-510, notice is hereby given that Harrisville City will be accepting applications from qualified registered voters in Harrisville City who desire to be considered to fill a midterm vacancy on the City Council. The unexpired term of this midterm vacancy will expire on December 31, 2021. Qualifications for consideration are: be a United States Citizen, be a registered voter of the municipality, and be a resident of the municipality for a period of 12 consecutive months immediately preceding the date of the appointment. Applications must be filed in person at the office of the City Recorder during regular office hours (Monday-Thursday, 8am-5pm, Friday 8am-12pm) and not later than 5pm on March 5, 2020. Applicants will be interviewed and considered by the City Council during the regular meeting on March 10, 2020, at 7:00 pm at the Harrisville City Offices, 363 W. Independence Blvd, Harrisville, UT.

ANNUAL SPRING CLEAN UP

Spring is right around the corner and it is time to take advantage of our Spring Clean-Up Days, April 13-19. Specific waste containers for regular garbage debris and green waste will be available at the Harrisville Main Park, 1350 North Hwy 89, during the Spring Clean Up for disposal. Please note, stacking and leaving items outside of the dumpsters will not be permitted and will be considered littering. Everything must be put inside the dumpster and left below the top line of the dumpster.

As part of the spring cleaning this year, we ask you to trim and remove obstructive trees and branches on your property or in the park strip. Trees overhanging sidewalks should be trimmed to the height of 8 feet in order to meet code requirements. Trees overhanging roads are to be trimmed to 16 feet as well.

Our annual community spring cleaning days are a perfect opportunity to get outside and enjoy the warming weather as we make Harrisville City a beautiful place to live and works. Thank you to everyone willing to help neighbors or others who struggle to maintain their yards and spaces. We can work together to keep our community safe and beautiful.
